Libya – March 2006

Colin Gordon, International Development Co-ordinator, completed a visit to the Fezzan area of Libya to study modern irrigation techniques and the traditional Saharan agriculture of the oasis situated in the Ubari Sand Sea as part of a curriculum development project.

This was in addition to the Energy Trade Mission to Libya.

Egypt - February and March 2006

College staff delivered training in Egypt designed to assist vocational trainers to become more effective in their work.

Algeria and Tunisia – June 2006

Colin Gordon took part in an Energy Trade Mission to Algeria in June this year with a side trip to Tunisia.

Training of iGDAS Employees – August/September 2006
